Do you have a tip or advise - about anything Disney Parks related - to share with our readers?

Always take time to plan your trip, before you go to Disneyland Paris. BUT don't hesitate to change your plans if the day doesn't go as planned due to heavy crowds or setbacks. You wanted to ride Big Thunder Mountain around 10 am but the queue is too long? Take a Fast Pass or come back during the parade (if you don't want to watch it) or just before closing time. Want to watch a show or a parade? Be aware of the schedules and do not hesitate to come in advance (between 30 minutes and one hour depending on the show) to be well placed and be sure to see it. Also be aware of the weather before you come to Disneyland Paris because a cold and rainy day can ruin your experience if you are not prepared (coat, umbrella, ...).
