Letting the public know what was in stock was just as important as the backstory behind the fictional characters running the shops of the Black Spire Outpost.

Our coverage of the opening of Galaxy's Edge on its first day was live streamed on IG and we had people tuning in from all over the world. Since then, we have streamed many times from the fictional planet of Batuu for those who have not had the chance to experience it themselves. Recently, we live streamed the fan gathering for the Wookiee Holiday of Life Day from Disneyland. This event was completely fan organized and we were happy to contribute our time towards publicizing it.

#### How and when did your love for Disney Parks start?

Bobby: I grew up in Florida so driving out to Orlando to visit Walt Disney World was a yearly occurrence. Later, Epcot and the formally known as Disney/MGM Studios parks would become yearly adventures. Once moving to Los Angeles in the mid 90s, I didn't visit Disneyland for a decade. Even before Disney bought Star Wars, I got myself an Annual Pass and found myself going frequently with friends. I think I gave a few of them the Disney bug because they all ended up getting Annual Passes as well!

Nadia: It's always been there since I was a kid. I live in Southern California and I would always visit. I got my first annual pass as a teen. I rekindled my annual pass love as an adult in the past few years.

I also enjoy screaming my head off in the rollercoasters, so "Big Thunder Mountain", "Space Mountain", and the "Incredicoaster" are also very much enjoyed. As for a live show, I love watching the "Tangled Storytelling" at Royal Theatre.

Bobby: "Smuggler's Run" is a childhood adventure come true for me, so I might also have to say it's my favorite. "Space Mountain", "Star Tours", and "Guardians of the Galaxy Mission: Breakout" are must do's for me. I love the "Electrical Light Parade" and there is nothing like watching fireworks in Batuu over the Millennium Falcon is quite the site indeed.

What's your most memorable Disney Parks moment? Tell us all about it please!

Nadia: Probably the time I was dressed in a Starfleet Uniform from Star Trek in Batuu and the Stormtroopers escorted me to Kylo Ren for "questioning".
