Even though we loved exploring Walt Disney World, our home park is and will always be Disneyland Park, Disneyland Paris. Every time we walk past Fantasia Gardens we feel at home.

#### Tell us something about the format of your online platform(s), how it all started, which Disney Parks you cover, and why you love to put such a lot of effort in those activities.

Our Instagram is mainly used for photos, the website for news and reviews and Twitter for all of them.

We started our Instagram account at The Market House Deli looking over Main Street USA. Due to Pelle's hobby, photography, we made many great pictures during our Disney trips and we really wanted to share them. A new passion was born: Lost In The Magic.

Later we added our Twitter account to stay on top of all things Disney.

We also had a lot that we wanted to share, but didn't have the right place yet, so we made our own website and started writing everything we wanted to share.

Every Tuesdays we post a random Disney related post, that can vary from a hotel review, a collection we own and even some facts about the Parks. On Fridays we post a weekly news update, where you can find almost everything Disney related that happened that week.

We mostly cover our experiences at Disneyland Paris and Walt Disney World, but we try to include all six resorts in our news.

We spend so much time on Disney every single day and love to get our excitement out of our system and share it with people who like it too.

#### How and when did your love for Disney Parks start?

For Lisanne it all started back at 2001 when she was just 5 years old when her grandparents took her to Disneyland Paris. When looking at the Main Street Electrical Parade, she was taken by the magic.



For Pelle it began in 2015 when Lisanne insisted to take him to Disneyland Paris. Because of his anxiety for rollercoasters he was very resistant. But Disneyland Paris turned out to be one of the best experiences ever and we share our Disney love ever since.

We try to go every two months to Disneyland Paris and stay most of the times for 3 days. So that means that we spend 18 days a year in Disneyland Paris. But we would love to go more often, maybe even every other month.

**Please name your favorite Disney attractions, parades, or shows.**

Pelle's favorite attraction is "Big Thunder Mountain" in Disneyland Paris and Lisanne's is the "Seven Dwarf Main Train" in Magic Kingdom (Walt Disney World). But we also like the following very much: Peter Pan, all Mansions / Manors, The People Mover and Soarin'.

Pelle's favorite parade at this moment is the "Jungle Book Jive" and Lisanne's favorite parade ever is "The Main Street Electrical Parade".

And last, our favorite show is "Mickey and the Magician" at Walt Disney's Studios (Paris). We try to see it at least once every time we visit. We've seen it over 10 times right now.

**What's your most memorable Disney Parks moment? Tell us all about it please!**

Pelle's most memorable moment must be our engagement in 2017 in front of Sleeping Beauty's Castle surrounded by family.

Of course, that's also a very special moment for Lisanne, but she also can't forget about the first time she got to see a parade, the "Disney's Imagination Parade" when she was very young. A dancer started dancing in front of her and made her feel really special.

**Do you have a tip or advise - about anything Disney Parks related - to share with our readers?**

Another advice is to be well prepared for your Disney trip but also try to have a relaxing visit and let the magic lead you.

- 2. Keep the parks and hotels really up to par with more frequent small maintenance like a bit of paint or just some cleaning in the more difficult places.*
- 3. Expand faster (rides, shows, hotels, 3<sup>rd</sup> park) to raise capacity, add new excitement on a more frequent base, and stay up-to-date with the latest Disney movie releases in the parks.*
