Growing up in Central Florida, everyone assumes I went to Disney all the time. But that's not the case. We went maybe every couple of years, and it was usually when someone came to visit from out of town. Once I became an adult, I quickly grabbed annual passes and the obsession began.

Q 06 | THE TRIPS

How many times/days a year do you visit Disney Parks (estimate)? And how many days are most of your trips?

I typically will be at a theme park a few days a week depending on the season. I'm a local, so it's easy to get to them often. Sometimes I go just for a restaurant visit and a couple of rides.

Please name your favorite Disney attractions, parades, or shows.

My favorite ride is the "Haunted Mansion" (specifically the holiday overlay in California), and I also really love the immersive environment of "Galaxy's Edge" (I'm a big Star Wars fan!). One of my favorite daytime parades is "Magic Happens", which just returned to Disneyland California. By far, my favorite nighttime parade is "Boo To You", which happens during "Mickey's Not So Scary Halloween" parties at Walt Disney World. I hope Florida gets a nighttime parade back soon year-round, as "The Main Street Electrical Parade" and "Paint



the Night" are so amazing. I always enjoy a firework show, and "Wishes" at Magic Kingdom in Florida was spectacular. For a stage show, "Mickey and the Magician" in Disneyland Paris was breathtaking.

Q 08 | THE MEMORY

What's your most memorable Disney Parks moment? Tell us all about it please!

When I was very young, probably 8 or 9, my family was at "Mickey's Very Merry Christmas" party in Magic Kingdom at Walt Disney World Florida. We were walking through the shops, and I heard a loud noise. It sounded like stomping on the ground, but louder than I'd ever heard. I quickly ran to the door of the shop to see the giant Toy Soldiers marching by in the parade. They were so tall and the shoes were so loud! But it was truly so festive and magical to see. They are still my favorite part of the Christmas parade.

Q 09 | THE TIP

Do you have a tip or advise - about anything Disney Parks related - to share with our readers?

My tip-prioritize your day. Know what is most important to you and your family, as sometimes you can't do it all. Plan what you can, but be okay with things going off schedule. Know your group, and take breaks if needed. Don't push so hard that the day is stressful and miserable. I see this often at the parks, families arguing and upset and tired, because they are trying to cram so much in. The parks are full of wonderful experiences, but so many are missed because of stress. Relax and take it all in. Also, drink lots of water. Most people aren't used to the physical aspect of the parks. It can be intense, so take care of yourself.
